## Future Events

The **Chili Cookoff** scheduled for March 7, 2026 at 5:00 PM. We are planning on 25 people and we have eight chili entrances. There will also be a photo booth with a saddle for pictures. We will be giving two awards this year: The "People's Choice" award for the best chili and the "Best Dressed in the West" award for the one with the most authentic western attire.

We discussed our annual **Children's Easter Outreach**, that is scheduled for Saturday, March 21, 2026 from 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM. Pastor will be in charge of the opening. Inetha and Isabella will be doing a craft. Lydia will be doing face painting. Stanley and Jose will be in charge of making hotdogs. We are planning on making 60 hot dogs with 40 juice packs plus bottled water. Pastor will be in charge of advertising on Facebook, post cards sent to previous year attenders, and flyers. We will be holding a "Bag the Candy" party on Sunday, March 15 after the Morning Worship Service. We are planning on using "lunch" size bags. Eggs will be redeemed for bags of candy. Five eggs equals 1 bag. Inetha said we have between 200 and 400 eggs. A firmer count will be needed to be sure we have enough candy bags. We will need people to be in charge of redeeming the eggs and distributing the candy. A sign-up sheet will be in the back of the church for hot dogs, rolls, chips, and juice packs. Jose will once again bring coolers for the drinks.

Pastor reported that Michelle Bishop is planning on holding a "Christ in the Passover Seder" on Saturday, April 4, 2026 from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

We are planning on holding a Game Night, Saturday, May 2 from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. We will conclude the game night with desserts.

Our annual mini-golf tournament is scheduled for either Friday, June 5 in the evening, or Saturday, June 6 in the morning.

We discussed participating again in Tom Huckel's Passover Outreach Banquet, held on Tuesday, April 7 at 6:30 PM. He is asking for contributions of \$35 to help offset the cost of one guest. The actual cost last year was \$69.
